## Overview

We are excited to return to Vail, Colorado for the 27th Annual Conference on Pediatric Infectious Diseases. Vail is a short and beautiful drive from Denver, Colorado and is a small community nestled in the mountains. This conference presents topics of interest to pediatricians, family practice and infectious diseases physicians, and other health professionals. Speakers cover the most recent information on diagnosis, management and prevention of infections in pediatrics. Discussion of controversial issues and questions follows each presentation. This conference is designed to promote information interchange, therefore, registration is limited.

## Objectives

- Outline the appropriate evaluation of international adoptees and the infectious disease issues surrounding international travel with children.
- Describe clinical manifestations and work up of children with sexually transmitted infections, noninvasive Group A Streptococcus disease complications, and Mycoplasma pneumoniae infections.
- Discuss the most important recently published articles in pediatric infectious disease.
