(Individuals who refuse to disclose are to be disqualified from any role involved in planning or implementation)


2) We request that you send your power point presentation and any materials for handouts prior to the presentation (Reviewed by TCH Medical Director to ensure compliance with ACCME guidelines).

3) Use of a "Disclosure" slide by faculty to be inserted in their presentation after their title slide. (Approved for implementation by The Children's Hospital Continuing Education Council March 2006)
