Overview and Target Audience

The NRP Provider Course, a program of the American Academy of Pediatrics and the American Heart Association, is an interactive course focusing on knowledge acquisition, skill demonstration, skill integration, simulation and debriefing. While this course does not guarantee proficiency during an actual resuscitation, it lays the foundation of knowledge, technical skills, and teamwork and communication skills that enable participants to continue development of neonatal resuscitation skills.

The NRP Provider Course is designed for health care professionals involved in any aspect of neonatal resuscitation. This includes pre-hospital emergency personnel, physicians, physician assistants, nurses, advanced practice nurses, nurse midwives, licensed midwives, respiratory care practitioners and other health care professionals who provide direct care during neonatal resuscitation.

Provider preparation prior to the course is required:

- **Immediately access/order the *Neonatal Resuscitation Textbook, 6th edition*** (<http://www.aap.org/nrp/track/NRP-6th-Ed-OrderForm.pdf>)
If you are a Children's Hospital Colorado employee, contact your unit educator for materials.
- **Self-study the *Neonatal Resuscitation Textbook*** (with accompanying DVD)
- **Take and pass the 6th edition online written evaluation, completing Lessons 1-9 in sequence within 30 days prior to the course** (\$23.50; continuing education credit is available) (<http://www2.aap.org/nrp/default.html>). Click on the purple circle that states "NRP online evaluation". *Carefully follow the instructions* which will ask you to create a user id and password. Complete Lesson 9 last so as to not be shut out from taking Lessons 5-8. You may retake a failed lesson once at no charge. Continuing education credit is provided for physicians, registered nurses, physician assistants and respiratory therapists.
If you are a Children's Hospital Colorado employee, you will be assigned access to the online examination through CHEX within 30 days of the course.
- **Bring your 6th edition online examination verification** (Lessons 1-9) **and lunch** with you to the course. **Please wear scrubs or uniform** to enhance the realism of the delivery environment.

A course completion card from the American Academy of Pediatrics will be issued for successful course completion. The card is valid for two years and may be renewed by taking a NRP Provider Course prior to the end of the month in which the card expires.

Courses do reach maximum capacity well in advance, as a 1:4 instructor to participant ratio is maintained.

Objectives Upon completion of the NRP Provider Course, participants should be able to:

- Demonstrate knowledge of neonatal resuscitation by successfully completing the NRP online written evaluation within 30 days prior to the course.
- Identify necessary staff resources and equipment for every birth to ensure readiness for a complete resuscitation.
- Name the most important and effective action in neonatal resuscitation.
- Demonstrate appropriate resuscitation procedures in proper sequence for a compromised newborn through self-instruction and team practice at various skill performance stations.
- Discuss special neonatal considerations that may be encountered and appropriate care.
- Identify neonatal resuscitation skills and aspects of teamwork that are well developed and those that require continuing improvement through simulation-based training and debriefing.

The course will be held at Children's Hospital Colorado, **Village Pavilion (2nd floor, Badlands Conference Room/Clinical Learning Lab)** at 13100 East Colfax Avenue across the street from the main hospital.
