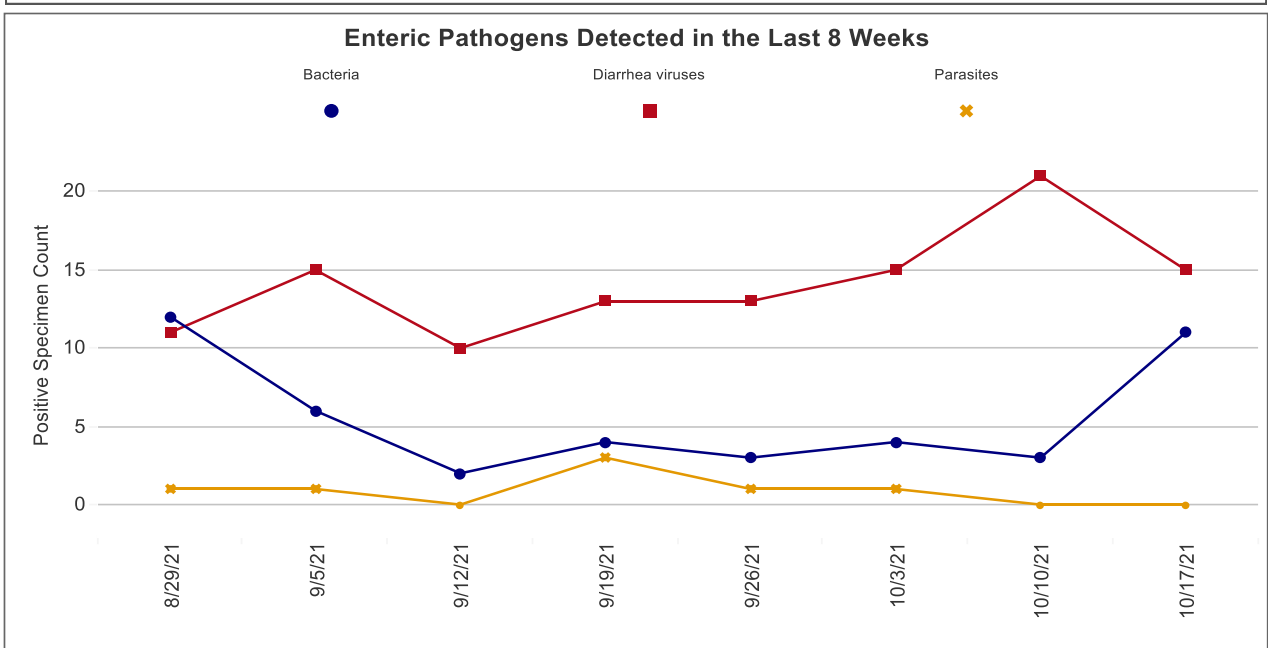
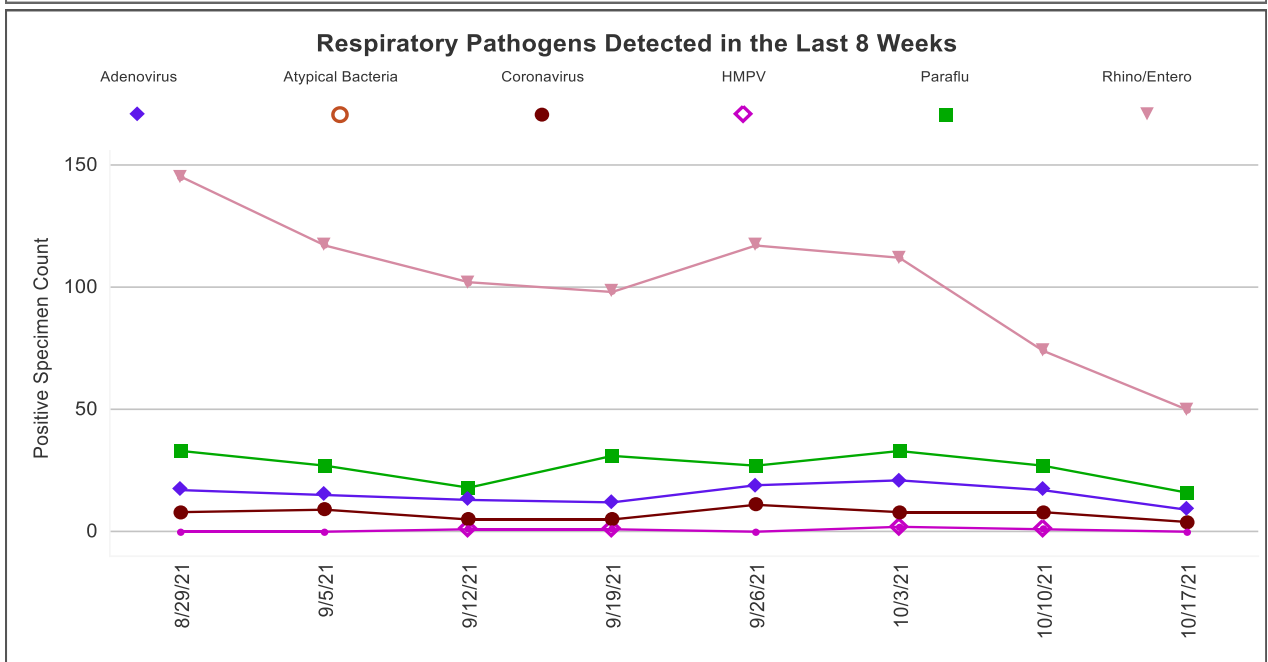
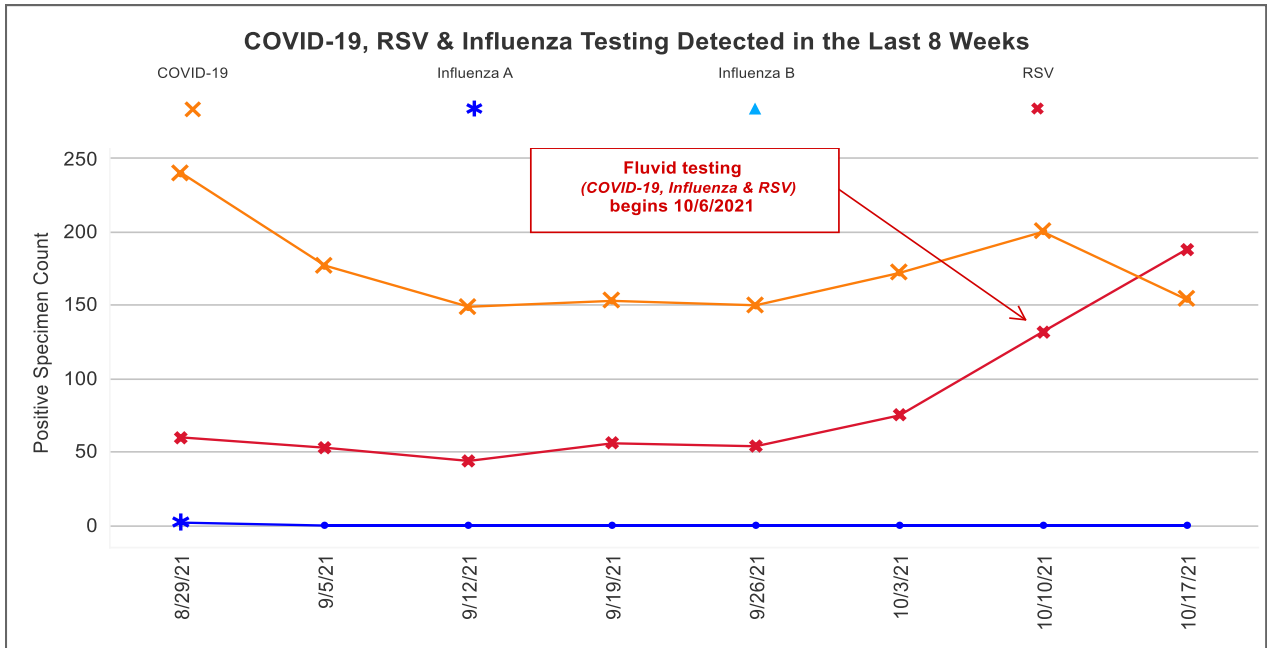


Bug Watch

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Late Breaker: We are still seeing lots of RSV and SARS-CoV-2 infections. Unfortunately, the latest wave of SARS-CoV-2 infections is not over in Colorado. The percent positivity in tests for SARS-CoV-2 and the overall number of COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations are still rising. The CDC released new guidance for eligibility for Pfizer COVID-19 vaccine boosters (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/vaccines/booster-shot.html>) and is scheduled to provide guidance for J&J and Moderna boosters in the near future after FDA review and approval last week. Encouragingly, the FDA is also scheduled to discuss Pfizer's submission for EUA of its vaccine for children ages 5-11 on October 26 with hopes of approval sometime in early November.



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
