Submit the \$65 application fee in the form of a check or money order made out to Children's Hospital Colorado with the Memo line "Clinical Nutrition"; or

Complete the "Dietetic intern application <u>short answer form</u> ". <u>Very important</u> : Please use only this form and complete your answers in the provided area as there are character limits (not word limits) to encourage succinct answers.
