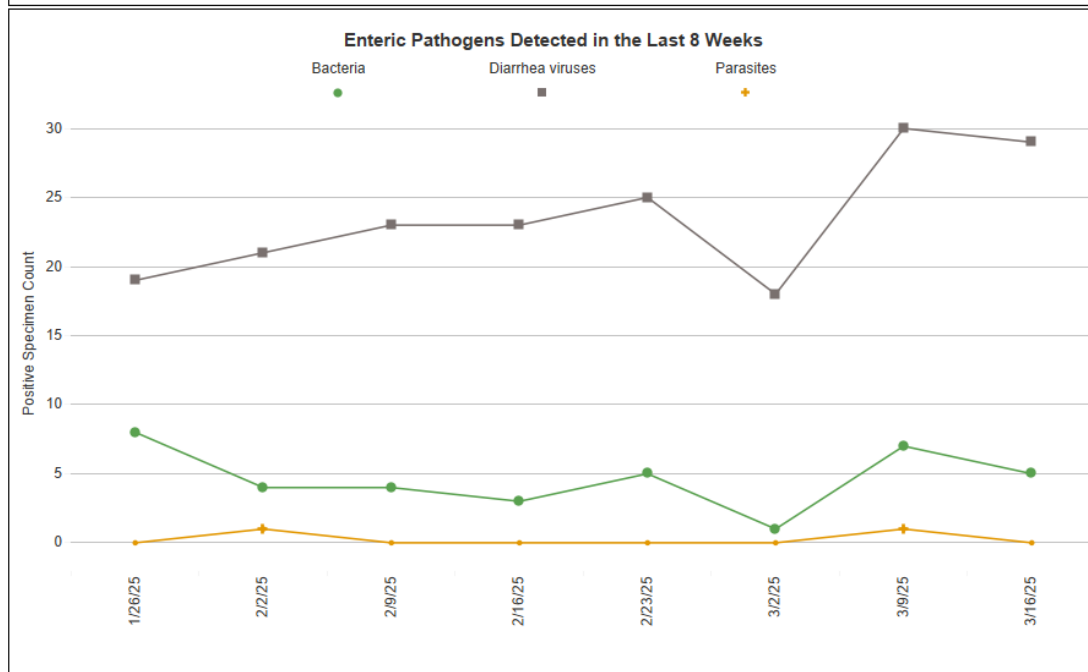
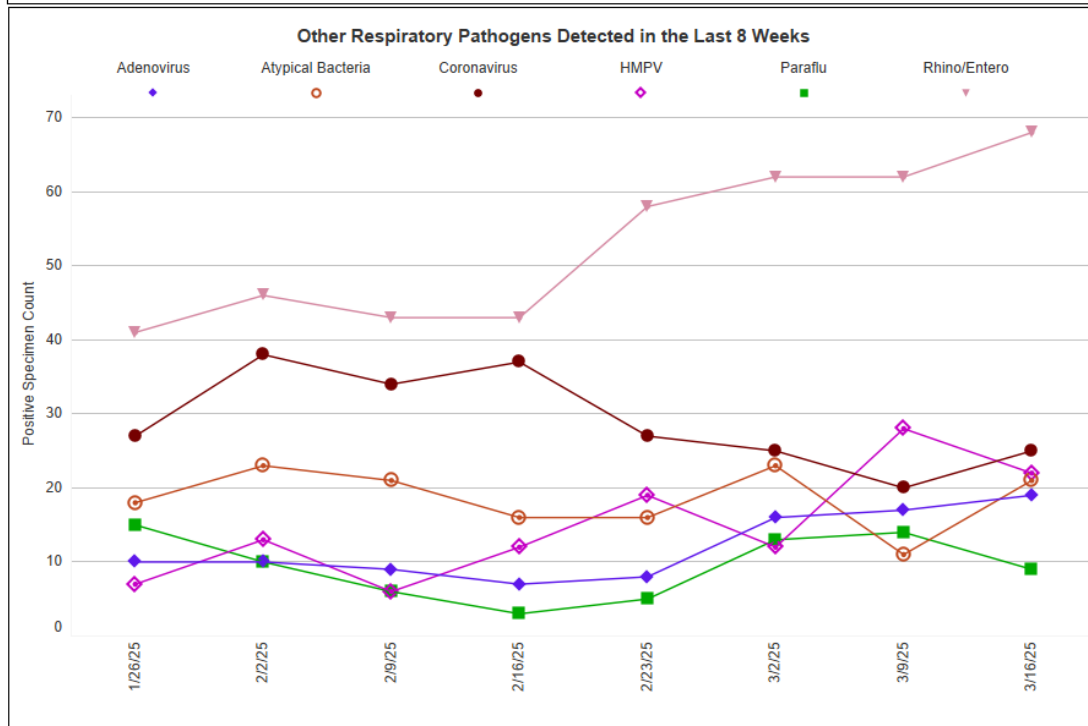
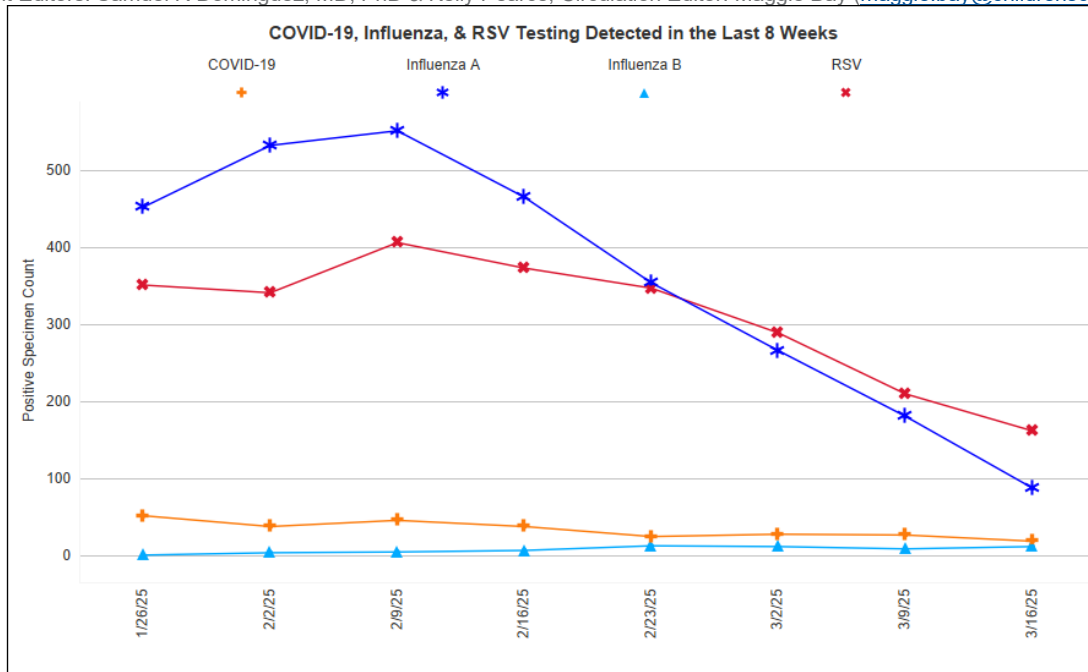

Late Breaker: The measles outbreak in western Texas continues, with spread to New Mexico and Oklahoma. As of March 18, there has been a total of 321 reported cases - 279 in Texas, 38 in New Mexico, and 4 in Oklahoma. In Texas, 99% of cases have been in unvaccinated individuals and two-thirds of cases have been in children.
