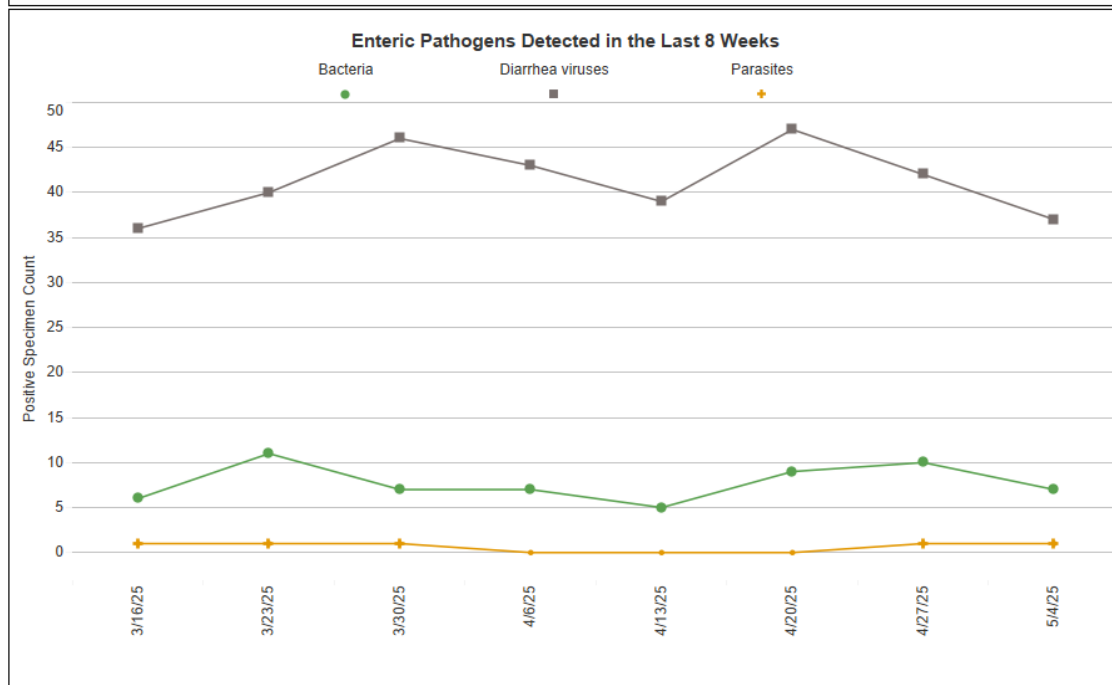
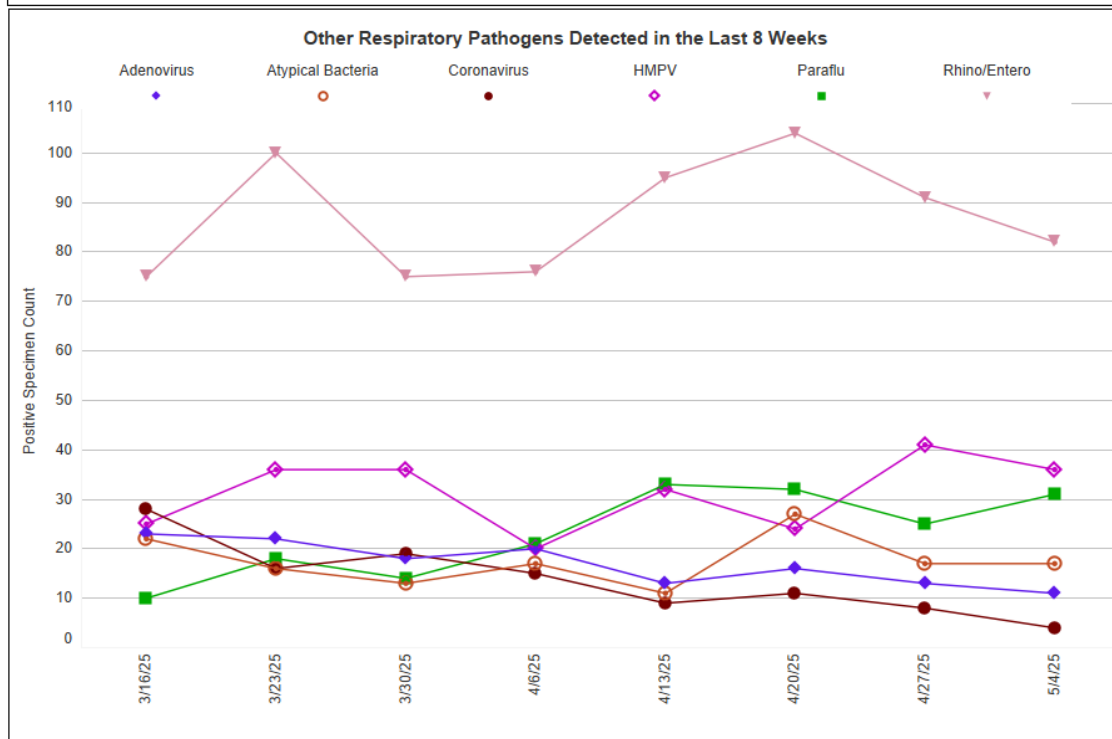
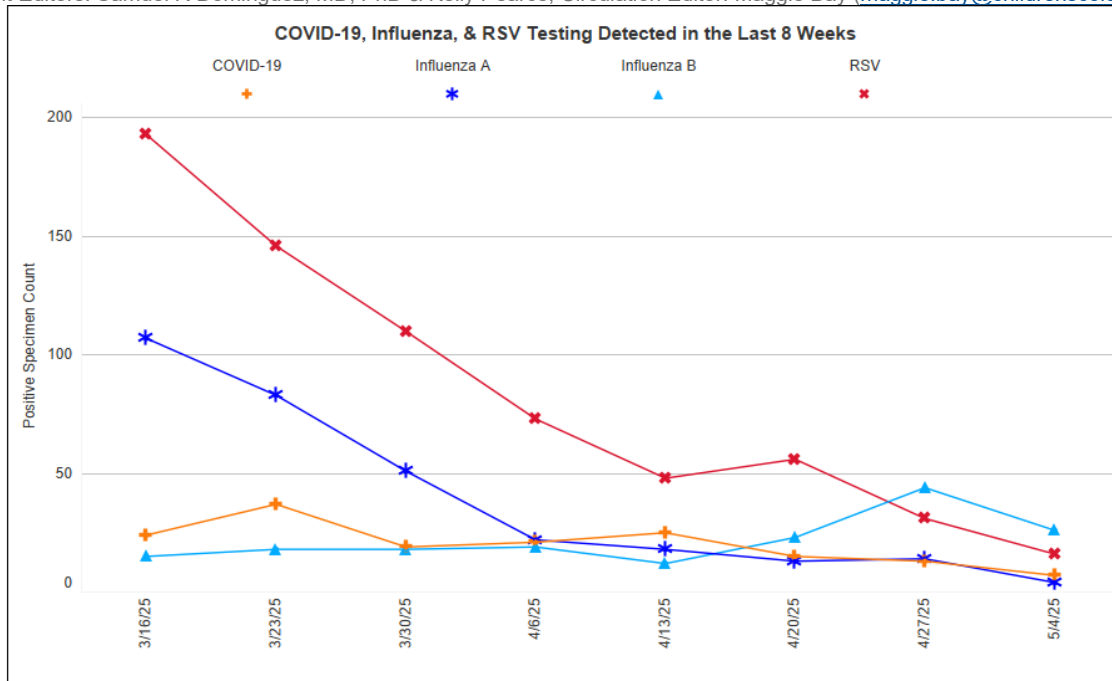

Late Breaker: As summer approaches, now is a good time to ask families about vacation travel plans and to consider early doses of MMR vaccines for children who are traveling to areas with active measles outbreaks. Children > 12 months of age can receive their second MMR vaccine anytime 28 days after receipt of their first vaccine. Children 6-11 months of age can receive a MMR vaccine if traveling to a high risk area but will still require 2 doses of the vaccine during the normal schedule after 12 months of age.
