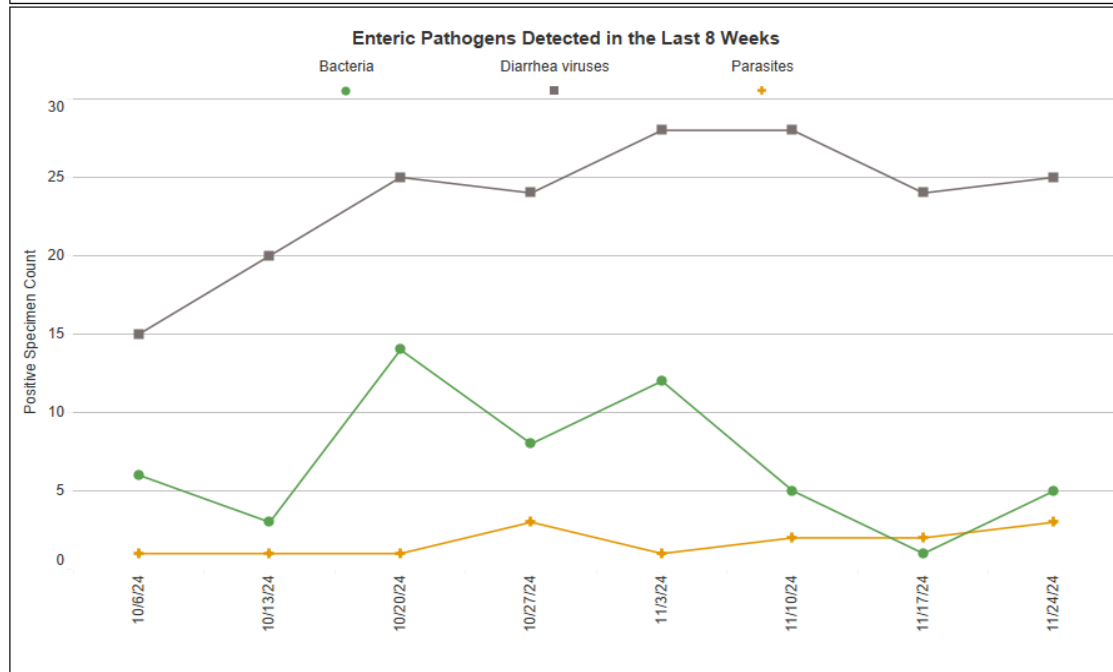
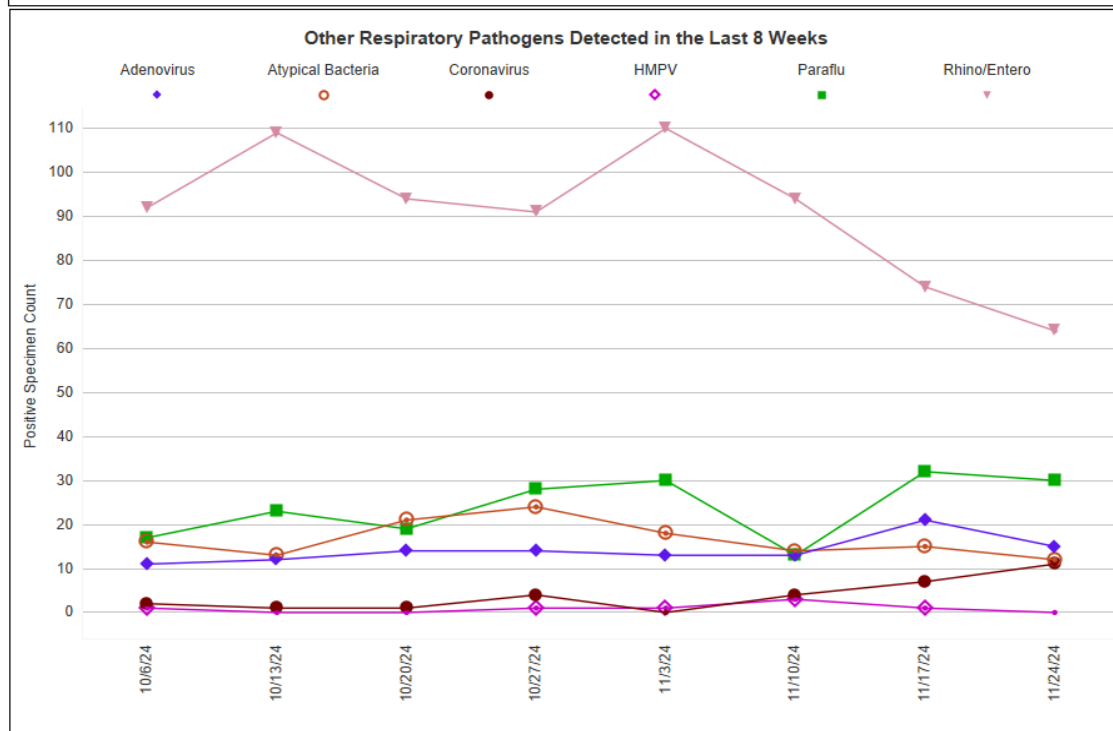
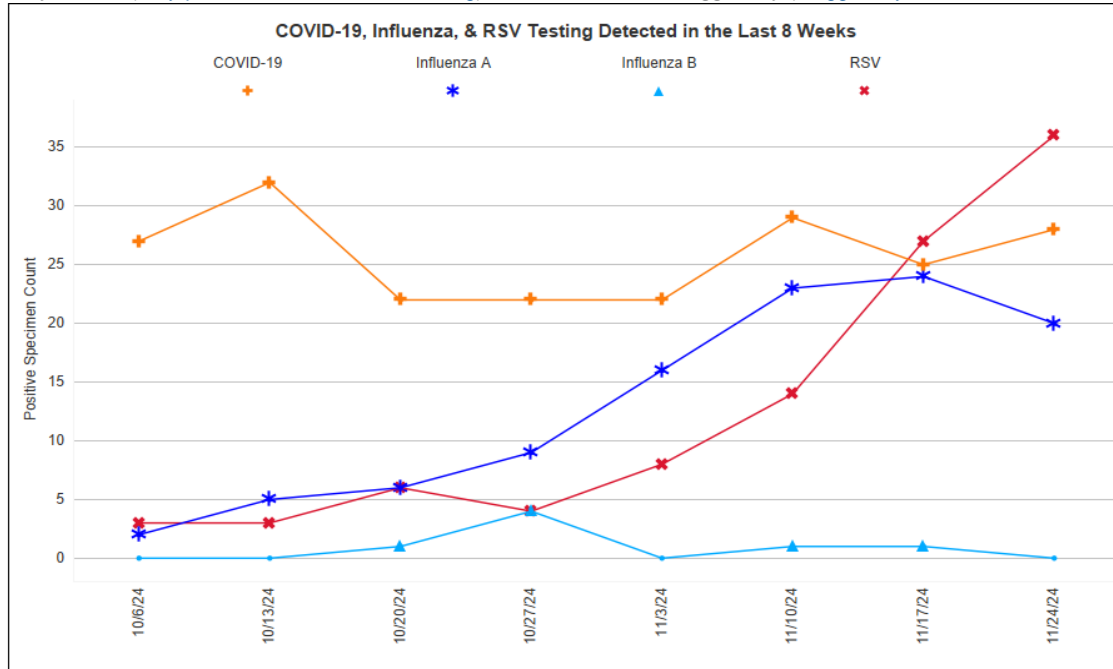

Late Breaker: We have been seeing a rise in the number of RSV cases, along with SARS-CoV-2 and influenza A activity, serving as an important reminder for influenza and COVID-19 vaccination. In other news, the CDC has confirmed the first pediatric case of H5N1 avian influenza in the US, involving a child in California who experienced mild symptoms. The child tested positive for H5N1 but was also found to be positive for other common respiratory viruses. There is still no evidence of person-to-person transmission for H5N1.
